The institution required to submit two copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Website www.aicte.ernet.in) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2008 for consideration of aproval beyond the session 2008-09. It may be noted that all the institutions are required to submit the Compliance Report along with requisite processing for by 31<sup>st</sup> August, every year, irrespective of the period of approval.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the brm of demand draft in the favor of "The Member Secretary, AICTL", payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the statue in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any prior notice.

The approval if granted after rectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfillment of the following general conditions:

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Concil from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
- 2 (a) That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
  - (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
  - (c) That the curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation/assessment of students shall be in accommance with the norms prescribed by the NICTE.
  - (d) That the Institution shallnot allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start annew course(s) or alter intake capacity d seats without the prior approval of the Louncil.
  - (e) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under my circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
  - Indian and/ or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
  - (g) That the Institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same premises/ campus and / or in the name of the Institution without prior permission/approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
  - (h) The institution shall not conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premises/ campus under my circumstances. In case any violationis reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.

- That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.
- That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form.
- That the accounts of the Institutionshall be audited annually by a certifiel Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by se Council or any body or persons authrized by it.
- That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- (a) That the institution shall funish requisite returns and reports as defined by AICTE in order .
  to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic stanfards.
  - (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet lefore commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including facility etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
  - (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website Information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
  - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with madatory disclosures on fulfillment of the above confitions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time i.e. 31 August 2008 for the current year.
  - (e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/ or misrepresent the information appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of AICTE approval.
- That all the laboratories, workshopsetc. shall be equipped as per the symbi of the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 9 That a library shall be established win adequate number of titles, books, jornals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
- 10 That a computer center with adequatenumber of terminals, Printers etc. shalbe established as per AICTE norms.
- AICTE may carry out random inspectins round the year for verifying the staus of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and tandards.
- 12 That the AICTE may also conduct ingections with or without notifying the letes to verify specific complaints of mis-representation, violation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc.
- 13 That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid form the Lentral or State Government.

- 14 That in the event of a student/candidate withdrawing before the starting of the purse, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. Theentire five collected from the student, after adeduction of the processing of not more than Rs. 200/- (Rupees One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / thiversity to the student /candidate vithdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for institutions and Universities to retain the School/Institution leaving Cartificate in original to force retaition of admitted students (see Public Notice ACTE/DPG/03(01)/2008).
- 15 That the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in anyform, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. (C) 656/198. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the institutions, the Cound shall take the appropriate action withdrawalof approval.
- 16 That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council through various notifications in media including AICTE official website (<u>www.aicte.ernet.in</u>) from time to time.
- 17 In the event of non-compliance by the Kongu Engineering College, Thoppupahyam, Prundural, Erode 638 052, Tamil ladu with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions pascribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of its aproval or recognition, without consideration of anyrelated issues and that all liabilities arising out if such windrawal would solely be that of Kongu ingineering College, Thoppupalayam, Perundural, Ende 638 052, Tamil Nadu
