This year has been the best year for our college. Little is turning into a big flood, and with the hard work of every student studying in our college, working faculty and staff, our college has left a great track of records in all fields. Our students have secured maximum placements this year. Our students and faculty have exhibited their talents and contributed to the maximum to elevate our college as the best college at the National level.

The college witnessed many milestones in terms of achievements in Academics, Placements, Co-Curricular activities, Research & Development and consultancy activities. These achievements further enhanced and improved the quality of education and contributed to the over-all development of the students and college. I feel proud and privileged to present to you a brief report of the activities and achievements of the college during the academic year 2022-2023.

## **1.0. The College**

Kongu Engineering College, an institution of academic excellence was established by the Kongu Vellalar Institute of Technology Trust in 1984 by 41 philanthropists with an aim to provide value based quality education to young aspirants of this region and impart technical and managerial skills of a higher magnitude to meet the growing needs of the society. Starting with a modest annual intake of 180 students, the College has grown to induct an annual intake of 2346 students at present. The total number of students on roll is 8269 including 422 Research scholars. Out of the total student strength, 5749 are men and 2520 are women. The present faculty strength is 506 of which 247 are women. 251 faculty members are Ph.D. holders. In addition, 505 supporting staff are working in our institution.

### **1.1. Programmes of Study**

The college offers 14 B.E./B.Tech. programmes in Engineering, 3 B.Sc. programmes, one 5 Year Integrated M.Sc programme, 9 Master Degree programmes and 15 Ph.D programmes with a total intake of 2346 students.

### 1.4. Infrastructure facilities

#### Buildings and facilities

The college is spread over 167 acres of land. At present, the total built-up area of the institution is 22.45 Lakh Sq.ft. The college has an excellent state-of-the-art infrastructure facility that include exclusive air-conditioned seminar and conference halls in each department, 186 classrooms, 135 state-of-the-art laboratories and all other allied facilities.

The college also has to its credit an impressive array of industry sponsored laboratories and Centres of excellence in emerging areas of Science and Technology.

The whole campus has excellent IT infrastructure with connectivity through OFC and Wi-Fi in all buildings supported by 40 servers and 3590 computers. An internet connection with 1400 Gbps leased line is available. In addition, Audio-video conferencing facilities and effective firewall provisions are in place. The College has solar power plant in house with installed capacity of 680 kW.

An air-conditioned central library, with 35,370 sq.ft space, and departmental libraries together have a stock of more than one lakh books and journals. During this year, 4761 books are added at a cost of Rs.77.65 lakhs in addition to the renewal of e-resources and journals.

The college has extensive Sports facilities that include indoor and outdoor stadiums and a big 8 acre outdoor playground that provide ample opportunities for

the athletes and players for regular practice. The playground consists of a 400 mts Track, Football & Hockey ground, 2 Basketball courts, 2 Volleyball Courts, 2 Tennis Courts, Ball Badminton court and Kabaddi court with flood light facility. A shooting range is also available. The Indoor stadium provides necessary facilities for Badminton, Table Tennis, Multi gym and with full fledged Fitness Centre.

Other major facilities of the College include the Kongu Convention Centre which is a fully air-conditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of 4500 and an another air conditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of 600, 13 separate air-conditioned seminar halls in various departments and a Food Court.

Modern residential facilities on campus accommodate around 3140 Boys and 1750 Girls. 49 teaching and 31 non-teaching staff are provided accommodation in the staff Quarters.

**Transport:** The institution runs buses in 79 routes to transport members of faculty, staff and students covering a radial distance of 60 kms.

**Power:** Un-interrupted power supply has been ensured with captive power generation of 3125kVA from diesel generators and 680 kW from solar photovoltaic units.

**Water:** 24 hours water supply and treated drinking water is provided on campus.

**Dispensary:** Two Doctors, a staff nurse and an attendant are available to provide health care to the students, faculty and staff. Two Ambulances are made available 24X7 to cater to the emergency needs.

**Bank with ATMs and a Post Office:** The Karur Vysya Bank with 5 ATM centers and one a Post Office are functioning in the campus.

#### **Development of New Laboratories, facilities and purchase of Equipment**

This year, the College has spent Rs.705.89 lakhs for the purchase of computers, equipment and for establishing new laboratories.

### **3.0. Supporting Facilities**

#### **3.1. KEC – TBI (Technology Business Incubator)**

Technology Business Incubator at Kongu Engineering College is in operation for the past **19 years**. It was established with the Grant-in-Aid and support from Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India in the year 2004 at a total project cost of Rs.3.95 crore.

- **Incubation Activities:**

- **Incubatees**

This year, **fourteen new startups** have been enrolled and **8 products have been commercialized**. **Currently 30 innovators (Prayas-9, SSS-5, IVP-5 & Incubation-11)** are availing incubation support of TBI@KEC. Since inception, **TBI has supported 120 incubatees (out of which 27 are our**

alumni and 2 are Student Startups) who have developed 107 products in our TBI and launched them in market.

- **Interns**

At present 30 students of KEC are working as interns (either fulltime or part-time) with 4 incubatees at TBI in developing various products and services in the emerging technological areas, cater to the industrial and societal needs. Cumulatively, 318 students have worked as interns in TBI since inception.

- **Funding support**

During this year, under NIDHI-PRAYAS Scheme, 8 young innovators have been sanctioned Rs.68.50 lakhs (as grant) to convert their idea into Prototype and under EDII-TN IVP scheme, 1 MSME have been sanctioned Rs.5.00 lakhs (as grant) to convert their idea into Prototype. Since its inception, TBI has sanctioned Rs.843.01 lakh as seed funding to 80 beneficiaries (out of which 14 are KEC alumni) for the development of products.

- **State level Idea Contest**

"Startup Mania (2022) 7<sup>th</sup> Edition" idea contest for students and other innovators has been organized by TBI @ KEC jointly with CII-Yi Erode Chapter and NAN|NLF Erode Chapter. About 311 ideas were received under "student innovators" category from 55 Colleges in 16 districts. Around 34 entries were received under "other innovators" category across Tamil Nadu. Winners under the student and other innovators category were awarded a total cash prize of Rs.1.10 lakh sponsored by TANSIM, Startup TN.

- **Idea Pattarai (Kick start for Startups) & Marketing Master Class**

Idea Pattarai is an event for polishing startup ideas for young founders. The event happened in a workshop format. Hosted & Mentored by Mr.Suresh Sambandam, Founder, Kissflow. The objective of the event is to take out the rough edges and get aspiring or existing startup founders' ideas polished for pitching to potential investors, and customers. **35 young founders of various startups were benefitted.**

- **Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp**

TBI@KEC in association with MSME DI – CBE, EMD/KEC & IIC/KEC conducted One day "Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme (**EAP**) for **86 students this year**. Since inception, **43 EACs** have been conducted and nearly **3441 Students of KEC were benefitted.**

In addition to nurturing entrepreneurship and product/ service development, TBI also organizes training programmes, workshops to develop a talent pool of students. **During this year, 1 workshop on Design Thinking was organized benefitting 55 participants (students & faculty).**

Out of 9 **current Prayasees, 3 have filed patents and all of them have registered their startups** and 1 **got received DPIIT/Gol startup certificate.**

### **3.2. Industry - Institute Partnership Cell (IIP Cell)**

The Industry - Institute partnership Cell established with a Grant-in-Aid from All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) in 2002 is performing very well.

This year, IIP Cell conducted 10 training programmes for the benefit of industries. The cell has also taken up Consultancy Services, Energy Auditing, Testing Assignments and generated a total revenue of Rs. 65.88 Lakhs for this academic year.

The college has five certified Energy Auditors and Three Energy Managers extending their expertise to the nearby industries.

### **3.3. KONGU Community Radio Services (CRS) - (90.4. MHz)**

A FM Community Radio service with a Grant-in-Aid from Ministry of Communications, Government of India was established in the year 2004. The Service covers an area of 15 k.m. radius and is serving the society by broadcasting need-based programmes related to Education, Health and Hygiene, Environment, Weather, Agriculture, Animal Welfare, Market trends and other information related to rural and community development.

Kongu CRS has been continually evolving new procedures for the production of innovative programmes for the development of the Community and also by actively involving Faculty & Students. The special highlight is that 50% of the programmes are produced involving Community People.

### **3.4. Entrepreneur Management Development Cell**

This cell has been established with a grant of Rs.7 Lakh from AICTE to propagate entrepreneurship as a viable career and to provide training in entrepreneurial and management skills to students. This year EMDC has conducted 14 programmes.

### **3.5. Higher Education Cell and Competitive Examination Cell**

In the academic year, 2022-23, 17 programmes were conducted. Around 1200 students participated in various events organized by this cell. Some of the VIPs who visited our college were Mr. V. Vibhu Krishna, IPS, Mrs. Shanthi Mohan, USIEF, experts from M/s. Unacademy, Bengaluru, M/s. TIME, Erode, M/s. Career Zone, Coimbatore, M/s. Princeton Review, Chennai, and Education USA, Chennai. Special talks/webinars on the importance on Civil Services, GATE, CAT, GRE, GMAT, TOEFL and IELTS were delivered to our students.

Apart from the above, coaching classes are being conducted for the benefit of our students on Common Admission Test (CAT) and foreign languages viz. Japanese, German and French. This year, a foundation course on UPSC is proposed in association with ARAM, IAS Academy, Chennai for the benefit of students who aspire to attempt civil service examinations.

This year, more than 150 students participated in various higher education and competitive examinations, out of which 16 have qualified. Nine have secured

admission to various universities abroad viz. University of Hamburg, Germany, University of Milan, Italy, Florida State University, USA, KENT State University, USA, University of East London, UK, and one student has got admission in IIM, Ahmedabad.

### 3.6. Institution Innovation Council – KEC (IIC@KEC)

MOE's Innovation Cell (MIC) focuses on creating complete ecosystem by fostering Innovation culture across educational institutions. The primary mandate of MIC is to encourage, inspire and nurture young students by supporting them to work with new ideas and transform them into prototypes, during their informative years. The final aim is to end up with pre-incubation, incubation and graduating the incubator as successful start-ups. Apart from the Syllabi prescribed in the curriculum, students were also provided with the opportunity to learn about the latest technological developments through part-time and evening courses conducted in each Department. This year 87 non-formal courses were conducted.

### 9.6. Training to the Students

During 2022-23, 177 training programmes were conducted for students to impart necessary Soft Skills to perform well in the campus interviews and in addition to this 223 inplant trainings.

## 9.7. Other Language Courses

Apart from the regular English classes, our college offers German, Japanese, French, Spanish and Spoken Hindi classes to the students.

## 9.8. Other Learning Facilities

Students are also provided opportunities to improve their multi-disciplinary skills and knowledge in desired areas through video conferencing, webinars, by using teaching assistance software packages like Moodle, MOOC, NPTEL and through guest lectures, seminars and workshops.
